- 01 June 2015 : *Deadline of submission of panel proposals and paper abstracts*
- 08 June 2015 : *Announcement of accepted proposals*
- 25 August 2015 : *Deadline for full paper submission*
- 01 December 2015 : *Deadline for submission of revised papers for publication*

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Individual paper abstracts: *150 words maximum*
- Panel proposals: *panel description (200 words maximum) and paper abstracts (150 words maximum)*
- Panel proposals must include no more than four papers
- All submissions should include a short bio, institutional affiliation, and contact information of each participant (*100 words maximum*)

TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION SUBSIDIES

Travel and accommodation funding will be selectively offered to participants from developing countries and graduate student panel proposals. The APISA 9 Committee will make a decision on recipients of subsidies based upon the quality of abstract and need of the person submitting the abstract.
